Ahh-some Spray Cleaner & Deodorizer cleans and removes dirt, debris, inanimate scum & nutrients, particulates & inanimate contaminants from all surfaces. It aids in the removal of unwanted odors and other non-public health organic build-up that may contribute to unsightly deposits.

How to use on your Hot Tub: Odors are often generated by bacteria growing, above the water line, while your spa is not in use. After each use, and upon exiting your hot tub, spray AHH-some Spray Cleaner & Deodorizer above the waterline of your spa shell. The waterline is the 4-6 inch above the water line on your spa shell. On a weekly basis, spray the underside of your spa cover and around the headrests, wipe any residue that forms before closing your cover.

How to use on surfaces where water may have left residual evidence of scum, mold, mildew, soap deposits and the like: Simply spray the cleaner on the surface, wait 10 seconds or so, wipe and rinse the area clean. Safe to use on most hard surfaces, plastic, acrylic and vinyl. We recommend that you initially try the cleaner on a small out-of-the-way area to gauge compatibility.

DID YOU KNOW?

Did you know that the first modern hot tub was invented in 1968 by Roy Jacuzzi? Back in 1500 B.C. the Greeks would carve out simple areas around springs for bathing and holding clothes. It was in Japan, however, that the "idea" for our modern hot tubs came to be.



HELPFUL HINTS

- When purging your hot tub, use a garden hose to gently spray the foam buildup. Foaming is normal.
- After a purge, you may still see leftover "floaties" that will come out of the jets of your hot tub. This is normal and there is no need to purge your tub because of this. Simply use a skimmer to take these floaties out and enjoy your soak!
- Sticky residue on the shell of your tub is exactly what you should see and witness after a purge. Yes, it may seem messy, but this is exactly what we want to see after a purge. The "nasties" in that residue should simply be wiped out using a Magic Eraser or a clean rag. It's important to get this off of the shell of your tub right away and before it hardens otherwise, it is much harder to clean up.
