

Ahh-Some 3-N-1 Winter Pool Clarifier & Bio-Cleaner

This amazing product works hard to maintain clarity through winter or extended shut-down. No matter what type of pool or sanitizer program you presently are using, Ahh-Some 3-N-1- Winter Pool Clarifier & Bio-Cleaner will provide ongoing support and allow you to have cleaner, clearer water in the spring. Just follow these simple instructions and you'll be amazed at the difference Ahh-Some 3-N-1-Winter Pool Clarifier & Bio-Cleaner will make. Like we tell people, " it's not magic, it's science".

One container of Ahh-Some Winter Pool Clarifier & Bio-Cleaner treats up to 15,000 gallons. Ideally, you mix the gel in a pail of water so it dissolves. Now, pour the solution into the pool at various locations to ensure coverage. Note: If your water level is still up and your filter and pump can still operate, you may wish to circulate the water for a few hours and you can add the gel directly into the skimmer. This is not necessary, however, if you can circulate it for a few hours, this will allow for broader circulation. We recommend that you shock the pool with an appropriate amount of your typical oxidizer or sanitizer. Whatever you use in the summer months, use the same thing now. It doesn't matter. We just want to make sure that you do not add chlorine to a pool that is sanitized with a product that is not compatible with chlorine. Use approximately 1 pound or 1 gallon of liquid chlorine shock for each 6 oz container of Ahh-Some Winter Pool Clarifier & Bio-Cleaner. You should use additional shock treatment if the water is not clear and has leaves or other debris in it. Also, if you are covering your pool with a mesh or non-solid pool cover, you should add double the shock treatment. Non-Chlorine shock is also fine to use in this situation.

Step By Step Quick instructions:

Winterize Swimming Pools

- 1. Treat with filter operating if you can.
- 2. Adjust pH to 7.4.-7.8.
- 3. Adjust Total Alkalinity to 80-120 ppm.
- 4. Shock pool with your usual shock or superchlorinator.

5. In a 5 gallon bucket, mix 1/2 of contents from 6oz container with approximately 4 gallons of water. Mix until dissolved. NOTE: May take a few minutes, especially in col water. It is also OK to add the gel to the skimmer if your pool pump and filter have not been winterized yet.

- 6. While walking around pool perimeter, pour mixture into pool.
- 7. Repeat until proper dose has been added to pool.
- 8. Treat at rate of 1oz/2500 gallons.

9. Circulate with pump running if possible for 6-8 hours if possible.

10. Winterize equipment and install cover.

NOTE: If pool equipment has already been winterized, you can still provide some water protection by following steps 5-9. However, results may not be as good.
